08-69 15m Cat Ferry

The design is a hard chine symmetrical catamaran with 19 degree deadrise amidships. The rounded sections provide increased buoyancy tending towards a semi-displacement form. This decreases the amount of dynamic lift required, provides reserve buoyancy in the bow in a following sea and softens the ride. A strake on the topside deflects the "green" water and spray associated with cats in heavy going. This combination of features allows a compromise between good performance, a soft ride and the inherent stability found in working cats.
